Work platform to be installed between the existing girders to prevent material from fallling into the water. Decking will be cut out and removed in sections. Areas to be cleaned up prior to installation of new concrete deck sections


with installation of rails to follow. No works in or near the waterway and no visible structures to be below the bottom of the existing bridge girders.
